Chairman & CIO of Deepwater Capital Limited

Dr. Mingchun Sun, Ph.D, has been the Chairman and CIO of Deepwater Capital Limited, an asset-management company based in Hong Kong, since October 2014.

He was a founding partner and the Chief Economist of China Broad Capital Co. Ltd, one of the largest Chinese hedge funds based in Shanghai, over 2013-14.

Prior to joining China Broad Capital Co., Limited, Dr. Sun held the positions of Managing Director, Head of China Research and Chief Greater China Economist at Daiwa Capital Markets Hong Kong, after serving as the Chief China Economist, Head of China Equity Research and Managing Director at Nomura International (Hong Kong), and Senior China Economist, Vice President at Lehman Brothers Asia Limited.

Before starting his banking career, he worked at the State Administration of Foreign Exchange, where he published a book on the CNY exchange rate and more than 50 economics articles in Chinese academic journals.

Dr. Sun was ranked as the No.3 Asia Economist in the 2012 Institutional Investor Asia Research Survey. In 2012, he was the first to identify a nascent recovery in China, though he maintains his long-term cautious view. He has been an Independent Non-Executive Director at iOne Holdings Limited since 21 July 2014. And he serves as the Vice Chairman of the Chinese Financial Association of Hong Kong and is a member of the China Finance 40 Forum.

He received a Bachelor's Degree in International Economics from Fudan University in July 1993. He also obtained a Master's degree in Engineering-economic systems and operations research, and a Ph.D. in Management Science and Engineering from Stanford, specialising in Economics and Finance in June 2001 and June 2006, respectively.

Mr. Kevin Lai

Chief Economist, Asia ex-Japan of Daiwa Capital Markets Hong Kong Limited

Kevin has 20 years' experience as a regional economist, being one of the few on the street today to have witnessed the entire Asian Financial Crisis, from start to finish. In early 2014, he established three major "outlier" calls. First, he predicted the US Dollar would enter a new phase of strength. Second, he anticipated massive money outflows from China. Third, he argued that the CNY would come under immense depreciation pressure and the world should be worried about it. More recently, he argued that China would turn aggressive with its monetary policy, but that such a policy would ultimately be in vain. Kevin's views have not always been warmly received. Yet the eventual outcomes underline his prescience, with Bloomberg flagging that prescience in an article entitled "Yuan Bear in the Wilderness in 2014 Now Warns of China Credit Crisis". Born and raised in Hong Kong, Kevin graduated from the London School of Economics in 1994.

ASEAN

Will the outperformance continue in 2017?

ASEAN markets, in particular Thailand and Indonesia, have been among the best performers in the region YTD, driven by a continual stream of cheap money and quantitative easing. Our panel, consisting of the heads of research from our alliance partners in Southeast Asia, address whether this trend can continue in the face of rising interest rates, a strengthening USD and an increasingly unstable political environment with their major trading partner, China. We take a look at what's ahead for the markets in Thailand, Indonesia, Malaysia and for the first time at DICHK, Vietnam. Each head of research will present an in depth, on-the-ground analysis of what's driving their markets, including what to buy and what to sell in 2017.

Chue Kwok Yan has more than 15 years of experience in equity research. In October 2015, Kwok Yan joined Affin Hwang as the new Head of Research. Prior to his appointment, Kwok Yan spent 10 years at KAF Seagroatt & Campbell as the Director of Research. He was one of the pioneers in building KAF's Institutional Research expertise into one of the best rated research outfits in Malaysia. Prior to KAF, Kwok Yan spent a year at CLSA Malaysia as a senior staff member in Equity Research. Before that, he was with ABN Amro Malaysia, where he began his career and rose to the position of Assistant Director in five years. Kwok Yan graduated from Imperial College of Science, Technology and Medicine with a degree in Electrical & Electronics Engineering.

Mr. Harry Su Head of Research Bahana Securities | Indonesia

Harry Su has been working in the Jakarta capital market since 1993. He spent five years at CLSA as Deputy Research Director covering the Indonesian consumer sector. In 1998, he became Research Director at BNP Paribas, where in the next 10 years he was responsible for carrying out a combination of Indonesian market strategy and coverage of the telco and consumer sectors. Since 2008, he has joined state-owned Bahana Securities, a leading local brokerage, as Senior Associate Director and Head of Research. Starting July 2013, he is also Bahana's Head of Equities. Harry is responsible for developing the current Daiwa-Bahana co-branded research, which commenced in November 2013. Since 1995, Harry has consistently been a rated equity analyst in various internal as well as external investors' polls.

A view on Macau's political and policy environment

Mr. José Pereira Coutinho has a clear view of the issues facing the gaming sector from a legal standpoint, given his career in law prior to his entry into politics. Mr. Pereira Coutinho is one of the longest-serving directly elected members of the assembly (on his 3rd term, with almost 12 years in office) and has been among the most vocal on issues relating to the Gaming Sector.

Mr. Jamie Soo Consumer & Gaming Analyst of Daiwa Capital Markets Hong Kong Limited

Jamie Soo joined Daiwa Capital Markets in November 2013 as an analyst covering the Hong Kong and China Consumer Sector. As the Regional Head of Gaming at Daiwa, he has been responsible for several differentiated research reports on the Macau Gaming Sector. He was one of the first analysts to debunk the "build it and they will come" mantra in the sector in late-2014, and was named the industry's top-ranked analyst by Bloomberg in late-2015.
